AN ORDINANCE WHICH AMENDS (ORDINANCE NO. 88-5 CHAPTER 62 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF TAYLOR COUNTY, TO AMEND SECTION 62-32) REMOVAL OF MATERIALS FROM DISPOSAL SITES OR RECEPTACLES AND TO PROVIDE A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION, TO AMEND (ORDINANCE 88-5 SECTION 62-34 DISPOSAL OF LIMBS), PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Taylor County, Florida has determined that to better serve the needs and health of the citizens of Taylor County, Florida, it is necessary to amend (Ordinance No. 88-5 Section 62 of the Taylor County Code of Ordinances).

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF TAYLOR COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:

SECTION 1. Section 62-32 REMOVAL OF MATERIALS FROM DISPOSAL SITES OR RECEPTABLES, paragraph (c) is amended as follows: Any person or entity who violates the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a civil infraction and subject to a civil infraction fine of up to \$500.00.

SECTION 2. Section 62-34 DISPOSAL OF LIMBS is amended as follows: All limbs brought to the roll-off sites in the county for disposal shall be no longer than 48 inches in length and 12 inches in diameter.

SECTION 3. Severability. If any phrase or portion of this Ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion.

SECTION 4. **Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon being enacted and duly filed in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Florida.
