ADULTICIDE TREATMENT CONSENT/HOLD HARMLESS

I, _____ hereby acknowledge that due to the health risk posed by the potential presence of West Nile Virus or Eastern Equine Encephalitis in Taylor County, Florida, I have requested Taylor County Mosquito Control to enter upon and adulticide (spray by truck) my property located at _____ to reduce the number of mosquitoes. I further consent to the entry of County personnel and equipment upon this property to perform these spray operations at no cost to me in accordance with the following terms and conditions:

1. Residents requesting on-property spraying must obtain an Adulticide Treatment Hold Harmless Agreement, review and sign it, and return the document to the Environmental Services office.
2. Upon receipt of the signed Agreement, the Mosquito Coordinator (or designee) will visit the property to inspect for compliance. The following conditions are required:
 - a) The house must be 150 feet or more from the County Roadway.
 - b) There must be an area near the house large enough for the spray vehicle to turn around.

- c) The driveway/house location must be marked clearly at the County right-of-way.
A number on a mailbox or fence or a sign with the family name must be visible to the driver at night.
 - d) The inspector will review all other terms and conditions with the homeowner.
3. The following conditions are in effect for spraying:
- a) If a property is fenced and/or gated, the gate must be open when the spray truck arrives. Spray drivers WILL NOT open or close gates. Mosquito staff will attempt to contact affected homeowners when operations in their area are scheduled. It is the responsibility of the homeowner to give Mosquito Control accurate contact information.
 - b) Livestock, domestic animals and pets (especially dogs) must be tied up, penned or secured in the house. Drivers WILL NOT approach a house if animals are loose.
 - c) The driveway and turn around area must be clear of all obstructions such as bicycles, toys, etc.
 - d) Driveway must be in fairly good and stable condition. Drivers will use the same discretion that they currently use on roadways. Standing water, sugar sand or muddy conditions may be cause for a driver not to proceed if he/she feels it is unsafe for the vehicle.
 - e) Spray operations during the summer may take place at anytime between the hours of 7 P.M. and 2 AM.
4. Taylor County Mosquito Control staff will monitor the number of requests and shall review the effect of a large number of requests on operations. Should operations become bogged down, staff will report back to the Administrator/Board for review/revision of this policy.

In consideration of these services, I agree to hold harmless and indemnify Taylor County, its officers, employees, contractors and agents from any and all claims, suits, actions, damages, penalties, interest, liability and expenses including costs and attorneys' fees incurred in connection with loss of life, bodily or personal injury, environmental damage, or property damage while, or as a consequence of entering on such property and aduaticiding by means of truck equipment.

By signing this document, I am representing to Taylor County that as the owner of the above described property, I am authorized to give consent and to hold the County harmless. This Consent/Hold Harmless shall remain in effect until I, as the owner, notice Taylor County in writing that I have withdrawn this said consent. Said withdrawal shall be delivered to the office of the County Administrator at 201 E. Green St., Perry, Florida.
