WHEREAS, through the past 17 years, Jack's unquestioned dedication to his community and his profession has restored the public's trust in the abilities of its government and progressed Taylor County to one of the best small counties in the state of Florida; and

WHEREAS, Jack's leadership will be greatly missed, but the processes, structure, and attention to detail will continue to live on within the departments of the Board of County Commissioners.
