WHEREAS, with the assistance of the Department of Community Affairs Waterfronts Florida Program, a number of public workshops were conducted to develop a long term Vision Plan for the community; and

WHEREAS, the County supports the community's goals of long term planning, increasing and maintaining public access to the waterfront, environmental and culture resource protection, enhancement of a viable traditional economy, and hazard mitigation; and

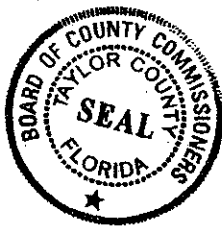
WHEREAS, the County encourages incentives for the development and preservation of recreational and commercial working waterfronts; and
